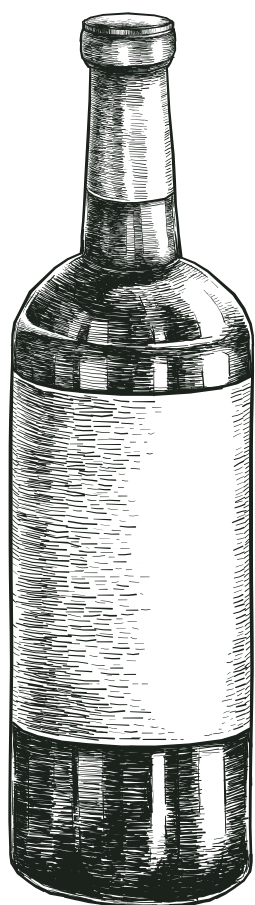

# Wines By the Bottle

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# North of Spain

## Rioja

As the most well-known Spanish wine region, Rioja is famous for its Tempranillo-based red wines. Regarded as some of the most balanced and nuanced wines in the world, Rioja's reds can be classic and oaky or modern and fruity, always featuring a ripe and velvety tannin complemented by elegant acidity. Rioja is also renowned for its dry white wines, made primarily from Viura and aged for an extended period in oak barrels. The region is one of only two Spanish wine regions with the highest level of wine classification, D.O.Ca.

## Navarra

Navarra is famous for producing a diverse selection of red, rose, and white wines, using many indigenous Garnacha red and white clones. The red wines in Navarra are often made from a blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes, and are known for their intense and fruity roses. The region is also known for producing flavorful whites made from Garnacha Roya (grey grenache) and Viura.

## Campo de Borja

Campo de Borja is renowned for its Garnacha red wines, made by small, high-quality, and authentic producers. These Garnachas range from fresh and fruity to intense and full-bodied. The wineries in Campo de Borja are among the finest in the Aragón region.

## Valdejalón

Despite not having its own "D.O" certification, Valdejalón is a well-known wine-making region in Aragón. This small region is home to historic vineyards that have been rejuvenated by newer projects that focus on its famous and authentic Garnacha grapes. Additionally, Valdejalón is known for producing some of the most exceptional Viura-based white wines in Spain.

## Pago de Aylés

Aylés is one of the "Qualified" Pagos (Estates) from Spain, and it has its own D.O. It's located in the northeast of Spain, near the city of Zaragoza, halfway between Madrid and Barcelona. The Ramón Reula family's wine project began in the 1980s and culminated in the reunification of various properties that had belonged to the so-called Finca Aylés since the Middle Ages.

# North West & Center of Spain

## Ribera del Duero

The Ribera region, located along the "Duero" river valley, is famous for its full-bodied red wines made from the Tempranillo grape, known as "Tinta Fina" in this area. These wines are known for their rich flavor, high tannins, dark fruit notes, and ability to age well. Some of the most renowned winemakers in Europe have found the ideal soil, climate, and grape in Ribera to create great wines.

## Castilla y León

Castilla y León, one of the largest wine regions in Spain, boasts some of the most fascinating wines without a D.O label, falling under the V.T de Castilla y León label. By blending local grapes like Tempranillo and Verdejo with international varieties like Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah for reds and Sauvignon Blanc for whites, many wineries are daring to challenge the traditional boundaries of the region to produce complex and surprising wines.

## Toro

The grape cultivation in Spain underwent a major transformation following the phylloxera infestation in 1870. In Toro, the Tinta de Toro variety thrived in loose, well-draining sandy soils, and the practice of cultivating ungrafted vines has been preserved until today. Here, one can taste traditional Spanish wine unchanged for centuries. Toro also produces some of the richest, full-bodied reds in Spain, characterized by dark cherry notes.

## Galicia, Bierzo & Madrid

Galicia is famous for its white grapes like Albariño and Godello. However, in Ribeira Sacra and Ribeiro, you can find delightful reds made from distinctive local grapes. Bierzo, in the northwest, is known for its Mencía-based red wines with fresh fruit notes and a fuller body than Pinot Noir. Meanwhile, in the central region of Madrid, young winemakers are working to revive old Garnacha vineyards, particularly in the Sierra de Gredos mountains, where the high elevation produces grapes with a complex and fresh fruity profile.

# Catalunya

## Priorat & Montsant

The secrets of Spain are kept within Priorat. Despite being widely known and appreciated throughout Europe, Priorat remains undiscovered by many. Known for producing some of the finest wines in Spain, Priorat holds the prestigious D.O.Ca certification. The unique combination of Garnacha, Cariñena, Syrah, and other grapes result in intense, fruity, full-bodied wines with velvety tannins. The "Licorella" slate soil in the region gives the wine a distinctive minerality. Surrounding Priorat, the Montsant region continues to impress with its exceptional quality. With beautiful soil and a favorable climate, Montsant reds are a true sensory delight waiting to be discovered.

## Penedès

Penedès is renowned for producing top-quality sparkling wine "Cava" and complex white wines made with the local grape Xareló. The region also boasts of producing some of the finest Cabernet Sauvignon wines in Europe. Additionally, it has its own variety of the Tempranillo grape (Ull de Llebre) and great Garnachas. Penedès' red wines are known for their smooth and complex character, with a lighter body than those of Ribera or Priorat.

## Costers del Segre & Conca de Barberà

Costers del Segre is the largest wine-growing region in Catalonia, spanning from the expansive southern plains to the northern mountains. It offers a diverse range of red and white wines, using popular grape varieties such as Garnacha, Tempranillo, and Cariñena. Conca de Barberà, located near Tarragona and south of Barcelona, is known for producing high-quality wines using both well-known grapes and local, ancestral varieties, each offering unique profiles.

## Terra Alta & Empordà

Terra Alta, in Catalonia, is the southernmost wine-growing region, known for its warm and dry climate. It produces rich, fruit-forward red wines from Garnacha and Cariñena, as well as the local Morenillo grape. In contrast, Empordà in the north, near the French border, is characterized by its abundance of local grapes and clones. Its most distinctive feature is the Tramuntana, a dry, fast wind that blows for long periods of time and imparts a unique character to the wines of the region. Some say the wind also drives local residents 'a little mad'.

# South East of Spain & Islands

## Jumilla

Jumilla, located in the Murcia province, is known for producing robust red wines made primarily from Monastrell grapes. The Mediterranean climate of the region provides ideal conditions for grape cultivation, resulting in strong, full-bodied wines with a high alcohol content, deep color, rich fruit flavors, and well-structured tannins. Jumilla is also recognized for its organic and biodynamic wine production.

## Valencia

Valencia is known for producing white, red, rosé, and sparkling wines using local grape varieties such as Bobal, Monastrell, Tempranillo, Moscatel, Merseguera, and Macabeu. Red wines from Valencia are known for their fruity and floral aromas.

## Balearic Islands

The Balearic Islands are famous for producing wines using native grape varieties such as Manto Negro, Callet, and Premsal for reds, and Moll, Giró Blanc, and Gorgollassa for whites. These wines are characterized by their freshness, well-balanced acidity, moderate alcohol content, fruity notes, floral aromas, and minerality, and are predominantly consumed locally.

## Canary Islands

The Canary Islands are recognized for their distinct grape varieties such as Listán Negro, Malvasía, and Vijariego for red wines and Listán Blanco, Malvasía, and Gual for whites. The islands boast a range of unique microclimates that yield vastly different wines. Many of the vineyards are situated on volcanic soil and are greatly impacted by ocean and Sahara winds. The Canary Islands are likely to offer the most diverse and surprising red wines in the country.

# Whites, Rosé, Txakolina & Ciders

## Albariño & Verdejo

Albariño and Verdejo are white grape varieties grown in the Galicia and Rueda regions of Spain, respectively. Albariño wines are characterized by their high acidity, floral scents, flavors of stone fruit, citrus, and minerality. Verdejo wines have medium-high acidity, grassy, herbaceous, and citrusy flavors, and an alcohol content that is moderate. Both types of wine are dry and crisp, making them ideal companions to seafood and dishes seasoned with herbs and spices.

## Other Whites

Spain offers a diverse array of white grapes, ranging from popular varieties like Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc to local favorites like Viura, Godello, and Xareló. Don't miss the chance to try the unique and indigenous varieties like Moll, Merseguera, or Forcada. Get ready to broaden your palate and discover the sensory experience these grapes have to offer.

## Rosé in Spain

Spain is known for producing high-quality rosé wines from regions such as Navarra, Catalunya, and Valencia, with a variety of styles from dry and crisp to fruity and sweet. The grape varieties used include Garnacha, Tempranillo, Monastrell, and Bobal. You can also find some of the world's most unique roses in Rioja.

## Txakolinas & Ciders

Txakolina and cider are traditional Spanish drinks. Txakoli is a white wine from the Basque Country known for its high acidity, effervescence, and low alcohol content, made mainly from Hondarribi Zuri grapes. Cider is a traditional drink from Asturias and Basque Country made from apples, with high alcohol content and dry taste, usually served directly from the barrel in special glasses. Both Txakoli and cider are commonly paired with seafood and tapas.

## Cava

Cava is a premium Spanish sparkling wine produced mainly in the Penedès region of Catalunya. It is made using the traditional method, also referred to as the methode champenoise. The main grape varieties used in cava production are Macabeu, Xarelo, and Parellada, though other grapes such as Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Trepat are also used. Cava boasts a fruity, floral, and mineral flavor profile.

## Corpinnat

Corpinnat is a Spanish wine certification organization for high-quality sparkling wines made in Catalonia using traditional methods. It promotes the wines of Catalonia and differentiates them from other quality sparkling wines like Cava and Champagne. To receive the designation, wines must be made from specific grape varieties, grown only in the Penedès area, and produced using traditional methods and long ageing processes.

# Jerez, Sweets & Beer

## Jerez / Xerès / Sherry

Jerez, commonly known as Sherry, is a fortified wine produced in the Jerez region of Spain. It is made using the Palomino, Moscatel, and Pedro Ximénez grape varieties and typically aged through the "Solera" method. The wine can be aged under a yeast layer called "Flor" resulting in a distinctive yeast and floral flavor, or it can be aged under oxidizing conditions, producing toasted and nutty aromas. Jerez comes in various styles including fino, manzanilla, amontillado, oloroso, and Pedro Ximénez and is usually enjoyed with Spanish tapas, nuts, cheese, or desserts.

## Sweet Wines

Spain is known for its sweet wines including Moscatel, Pedro Ximénez, and Malvasia. Moscatel boasts a strong fragrance and is made in the Eastern and Southern regions of Spain. Pedro Ximénez boasts a deep, dark hue and is a key ingredient in sweet sherry from Jerez or Montilla. Malvasia is characterized by its fruity and floral notes and is produced in the East and the Canary Islands.

## Spanish Beer

Spain brews various beer styles, including lagers, ales, and stouts. Some well-known brands are Estrella Damm from Barcelona, Estrella Galicia from Galicia, and Alhambra from Granada. Lager Helles or Pilsner is the most prevalent type in Spain, but Bock and Wheat are also widely available.
